

**SECURITY DECLARATION

We declare

- that consignments during preparation, storage and, as applicable, transportation, as far as transportation is assumed by us, to air carriers or regulated agents have been/are protected against unauthorized access.
- that our staff charged with the preparation of the consignments are reliable and have been familiarized with their tasks;
- that consignments are prepared in secure premises.
- that the consignments do not contain prohibited articles in terms of the Attachment (guidelines for classification of prohibited articles) to Regulation (EC) No 2320/2002 numbers iv) and v) acc. to point 6.4.1 (c), as far as they have not been declared in accordance with ICAO Annex 18 or the ICAO/IATA dangerous goods regulations in force.
- that the packaging and contents of the consignment may be inspected for reasons of security (e.g. random checks);

We undertake

- to renew the security declaration in case our company name and/or our address changes;
- to ensure the accomplishment of security measures in case we employ sub-contractors (transportation, packaging, storage);
- to grant the competent validation bodies (e.g. aviation security authorities or the regulated agent) access to our premises.
- to submit one original of this declaration without further request once every 12 months to the Regulated Agent and/or air carrier.
- that consignments are always packed in tamper-proof packaging. Tamper-proof packaging means in particular that the packages are prepared in such a way that no goods can be removed from or introduced into without leaving visible traces of tampering (e.g. packages shrink wrapped in plastic film), with the only exception of consignments for which this kind of packaging is difficult or which can be only transported separately and under constant surveillance. This must be agreed with the Regulated Agent so that the transportation route can be planned and set up. Without a separate written agreement signed by the Regulated Agent the obligation for tamper-proof packaging remains.
- to clearly mark air consignments as such, both physically and electronically.

For the information specified in this declaration we assume full responsibility. We are aware that in case of non-compliance consignments must be classified as "not secured" by the Regulated Agent and subjected to a security control, or in case of gross infringements the status as a Regulated Agent is in principle deprived.
